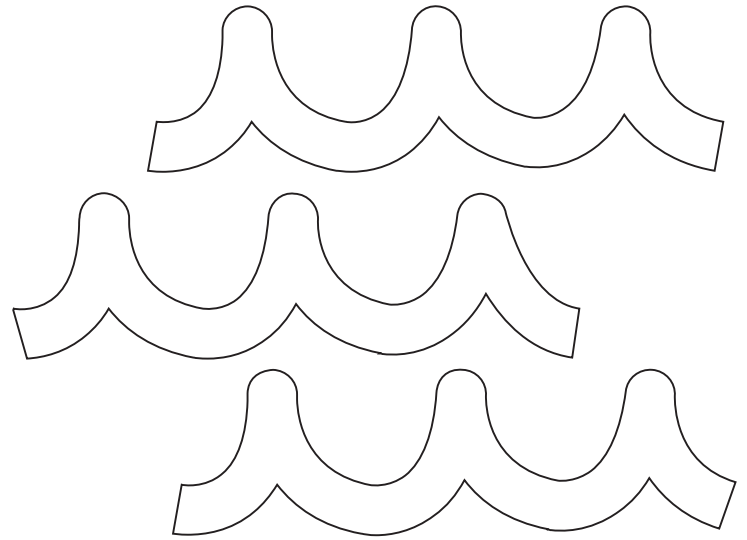
Fill the Scene

Jesus called him out of the boat, and Simon Peter started to walk on the water. But when Simon Peter got scared, he began to sink and cried out to Jesus, "Rescue me!" Jesus caught him and brought him safely to the boat, saying, "Why did you doubt?"
