

Trace the tomb and finish drawing and coloring the story.

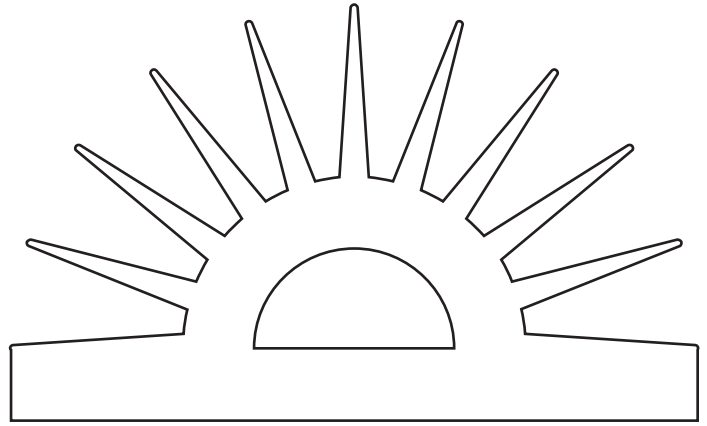
