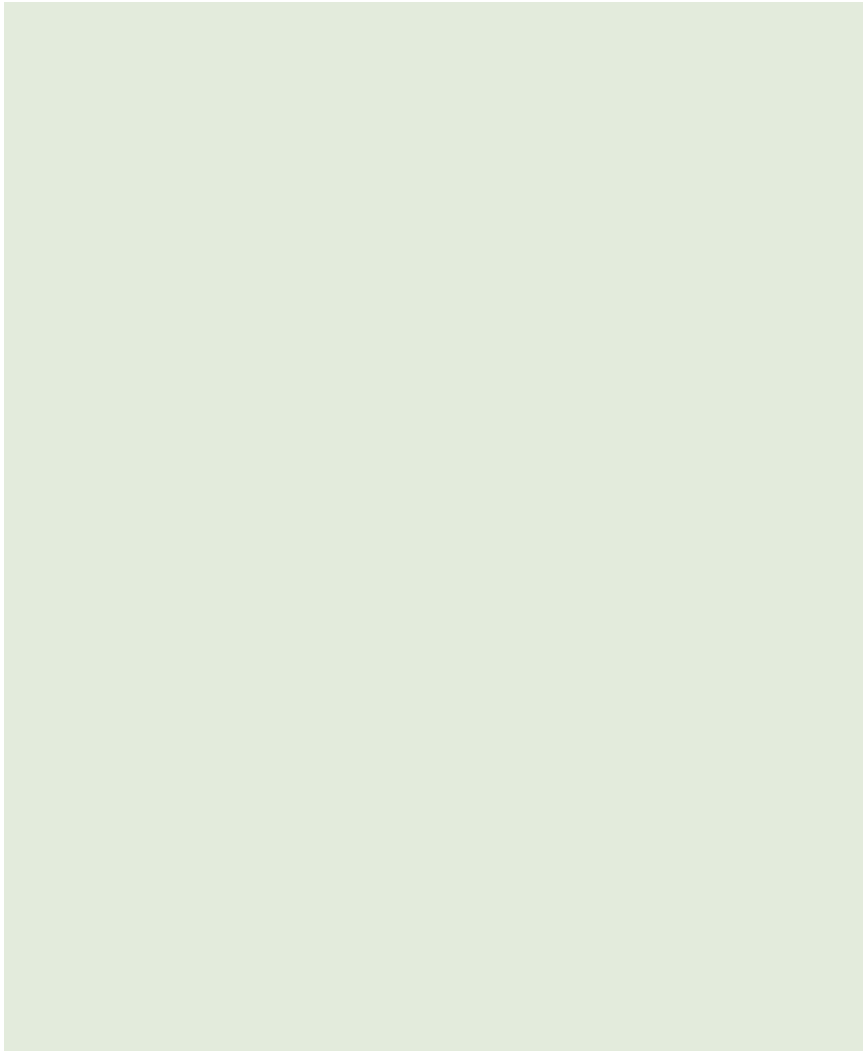




## seeking in the sanctuary
