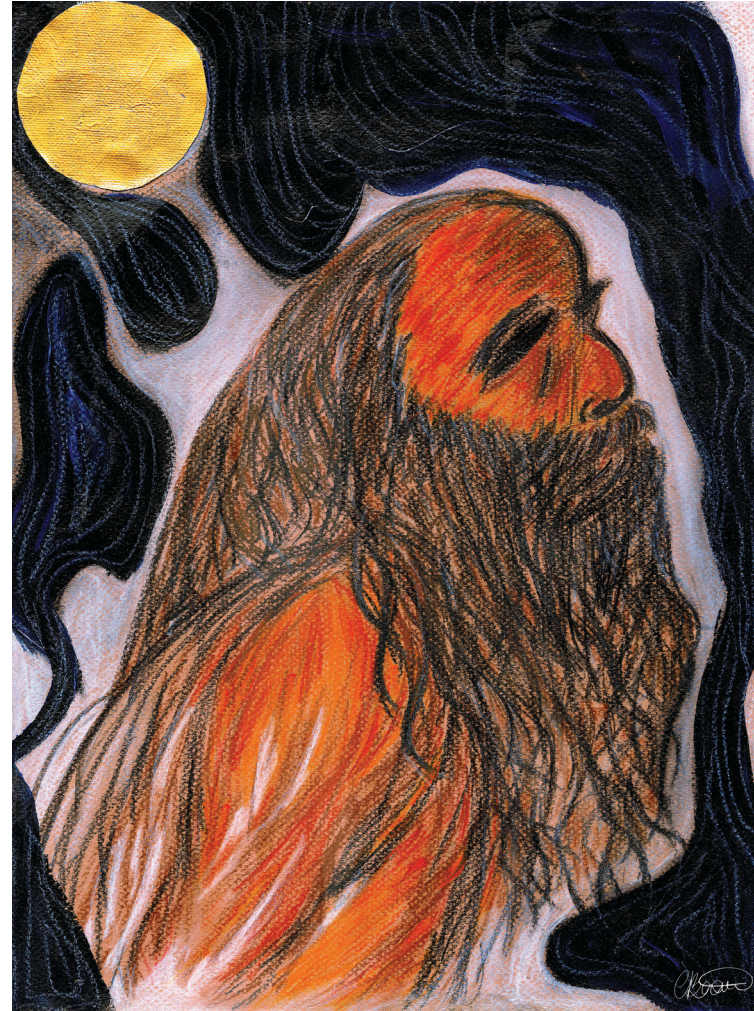
Look at the communion table. This is where we meet God in community.

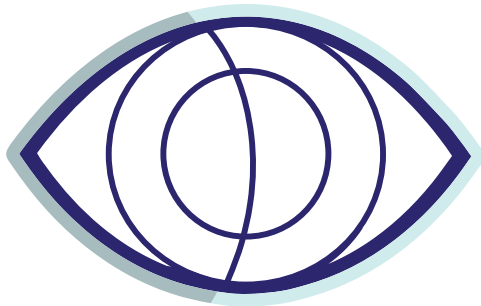
seeking in images
