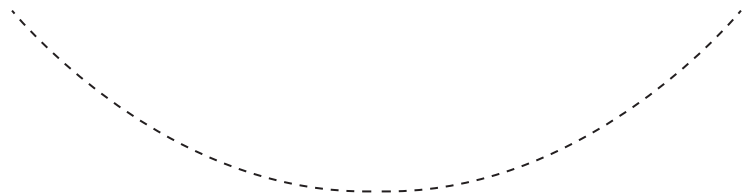

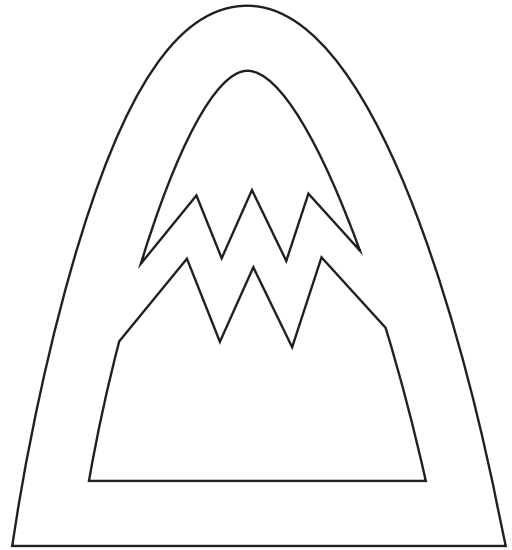
Fill the Scene
