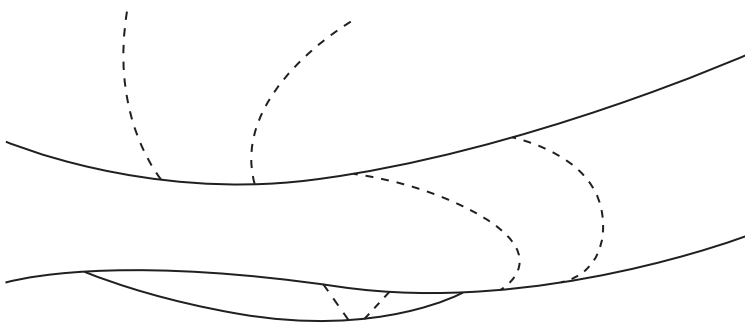

Figuring out faith with Peter

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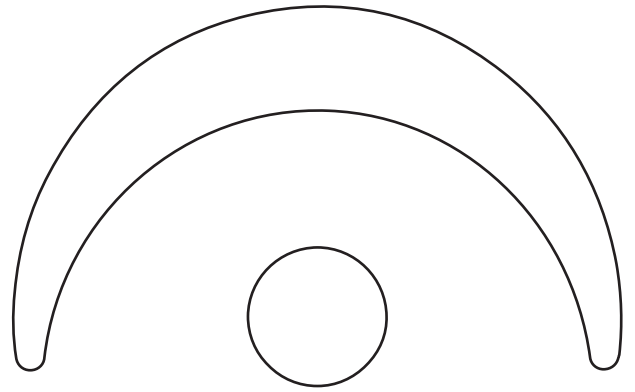
Trace the path and finish drawing and coloring the story.

## Fill the Scene

**Read** Jesus told his disciples that being the Messiah meant that he would be killed in Jerusalem, but would be raised from the dead. Peter did not like the sound of that. He told Jesus, "Absolutely not! It can't happen that way, and I won't let it." But Jesus told Peter, "Get out of my way! You're trying to tempt me away from the path I must take. I'm seeing God's big picture, but you're only worried about what's here on earth."



# Main Idea: God's way is the best way.
