

Trace the crowd and finish drawing and coloring the story.



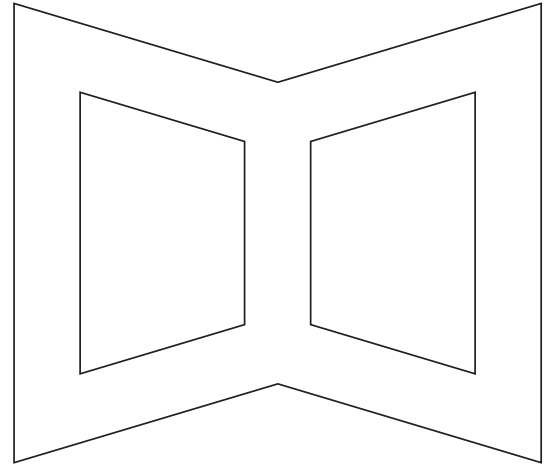
