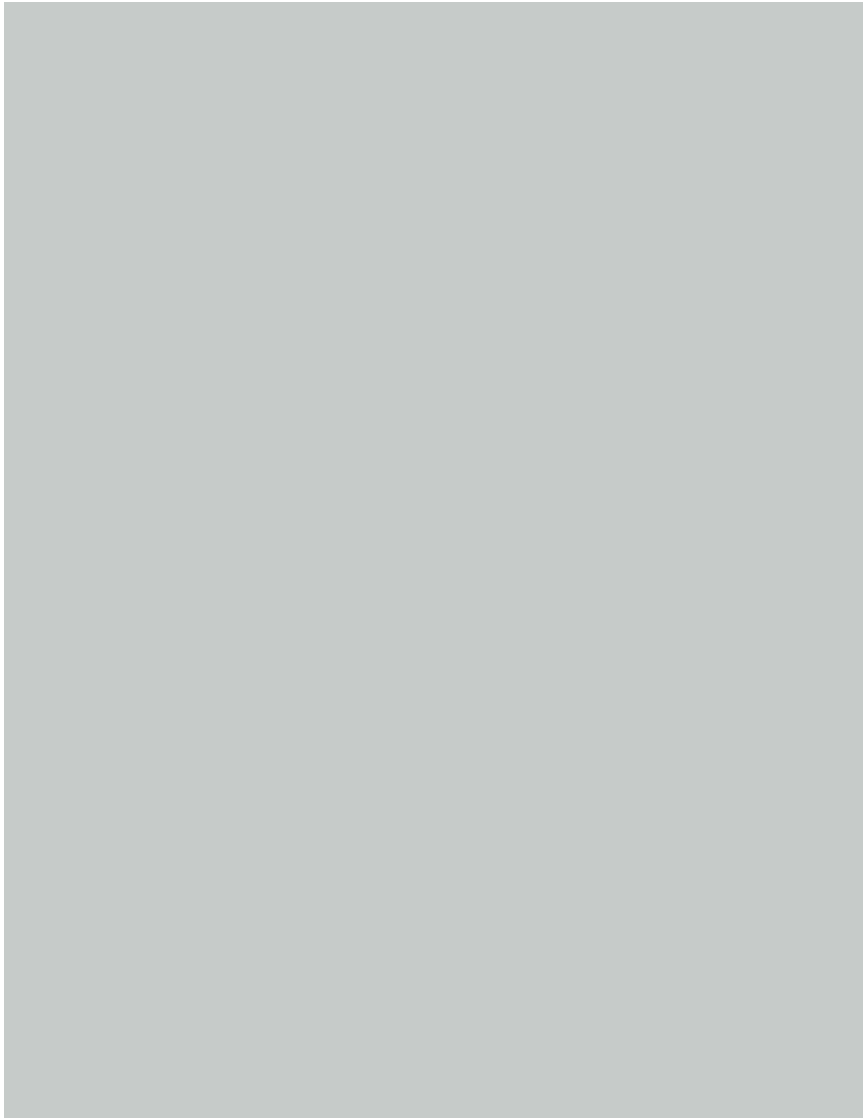

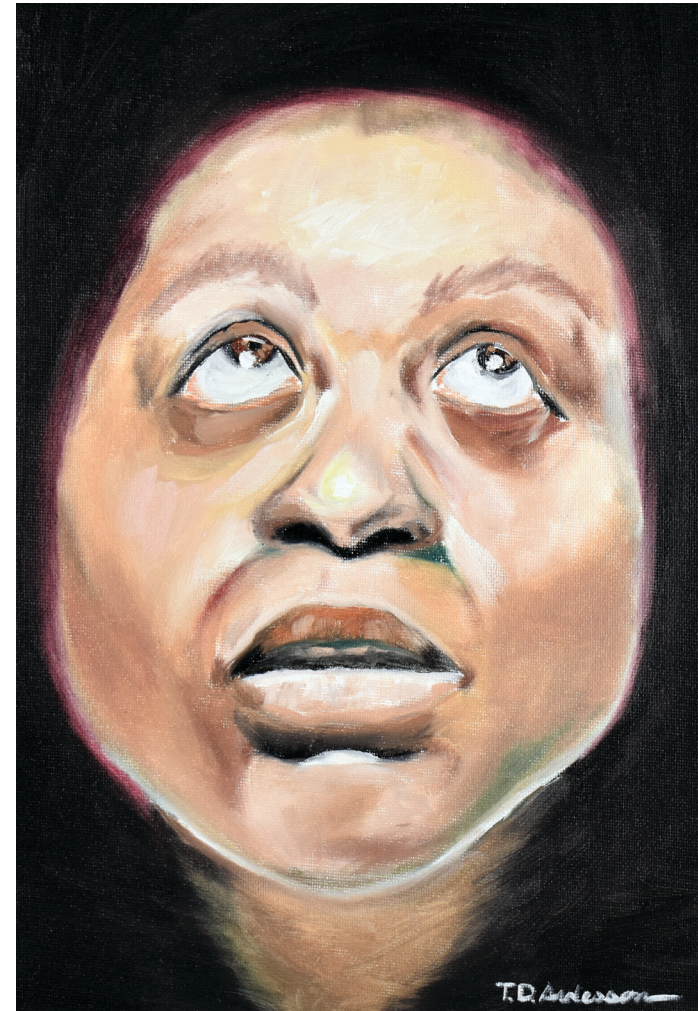
Look around the sanctuary. What is different today? **Draw a picture of what you see that is new in the sanctuary!**
