STUDY QUESTIONS FOR AUGUST 11 –

This is the final week in our Liberating Discipleship Bible Study and we’re dealing with the topic of worship.

1. Tell me about some of your best memorable worship experiences. Tell me about some of your most uncomfortable worship experiences. What did you learn about yourself?
2. How much do you think our bodies are (or should be) involved in our worship? How do you think the “body” is understood in the context of our text from Romans 12?
3. How do you define “Holy?” What’s the difference between “holy” and “religions?”
4. What does it mean to “present” ourselves as “holy?”
5. What is your definition of “religion” or “religious?” Is your definition fairly positive, or is there some negative baggage that comes along with this word for you?
6. Is it possible to be a Christian without being “religious?”
7. How is worship and social responsibility related?
8. Is worship something we can do outside of context of a corporate worship service? If so, what can one do to worship? How does Romans 12 help in this case?
